They reached the school by 9.15 A.M and got a good warm welcome from us. They were exploring the school and interacting with the children and teachers.

### HONOR TO THE MOTHER...

The function started at 10.15 A.M. **Ms.Kavitha [Ms.Mala's mother]** was honored with flag hoisting ceremony and she accepted that with great humbleness. We gave this honor behalf of all parents for her dedication in bringing up 2 children in her life after facing very tough timings as a mother. She was very keen in listening, observing, talking about various aspects of child care and education with all of us on this day. It is also a great opportunity for the village parents to see and interact with such good senior parents who have made real success in their life by their hard work.

### ***Her message to our parents...***

"I was very particular in inner order of my 2 children. We were also under poverty and I have to support the family by tailoring and selling bed sheets. Children were very much aware about the family situation and they did not demand me anything. I have also made them to support the family by giving part time work. Especially my son studied in evening college and worked for the rest of the day. But the inner intention was to educate them and finally they came to this position. But as a senior mother the most important need for the modern child is the behavior and responsibility which can be cultivated only by parents and school. Today at this age I feel very happy to go and see places were social activities like this happens and feel to mingle with them. It is most important for the mother in the family to have the **SANGALPA** for the development of the child and whole family."

"We were brought up with firmness and sometimes even our mother used to beat us. The main lesson she gave us was not to seek others help unnecessarily. Even though we suffered from poverty, we were very particular in accepting others help.

But my parents gave me the freedom to study what I need and choose my life style on my own. But in the beginning of my parenting because of ignorance I have missed the good time of parenting my only daughter but now I slowly understand her. Today I am serving many rich children in KG level as a parent cum teacher. I feel the most important part of a teacher and mother is to bring up the child with good manners and character."

Apart from this she gave several tips to the parents regarding nutrition because basically she studied B.Sc Nutrition.

She has gifted every child with a good quality water bottle and many good snacks.

Almonds, dates, greens, germinated cereals, egg, milk, peanuts with jiggery were suggested by her in routine food for the children. She has suggested giving non vegetarian only once in a week. Pure cow's ghee was suggested every day. Junk food items, latest snacks were asked to be avoided. The school also said that we will take away such snacks from next term.

Every child was rewarded with the narrative report and other work sheets. This time the narrative report covers were so good and well designed.

The welcome address by Ms.Shanthi and Thanking session by Ms.Sasi were very simple but clear. Good!

All the teachers served their food and treated the chief guests. Mala felt that she needs to stay for few days with children and show many English teaching techniques. By 2.30 P.M they left the school towards their home town.

After that we all had a meeting in which certain issues were solved. This time we have specially rewarded Master.SaravanaKumar for having double promotion in his school.
